MOUNT LAUREL TOWNSHIP COUNCIL INTRODUCES BUDGET WITH ZERO MUNICIPAL TAX INCREASE

Mount Laurel, NJ --- The Mount Laurel Township Council has introduced a budget for Fiscal Year 2022 with a zero municipal tax increase.

Township Council and management have worked diligently to make sure there are no cuts to public services as residents continue to recover from the pandemic. This is the third consecutive year that there has been a zero tax increase to Mount Laurel residents.

“Township Council and management are proud to introduce a budget with no municipal tax increase or cuts to services.” Stated Mayor Pritchett. “The cost of living has risen as we continue to navigate the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, so Township Council is delighted to be able to give a zero tax increase.”

The budget includes valuable services and amenities such as police and animal control services, EMS, free events to residents and families, trash pickup, snow plowing, road improvements, and other services that improve resident’s quality of life.
