

DOG AND CAT LICENSES REQUIRED

Dog and Cat licenses are required yearly. The deadline for licenses to be renewed without a late penalty is March 31st of every year.

In order to obtain a license, you must comply with the information requested on this application.

If you own a dog or cat, please submit the application with the correct fee, proof of rabies vaccination (vaccination must be valid until November in order to acquire a dog license) and a self-addressed stamped envelope to the following address:

Local ordinance requires that all dogs and cats 12 weeks or older must be licensed. Newly acquired dogs and cats must be licensed within 10 days of acquisition. Animals are not permitted to run at large. Owners may be subject to fine.

Check rabies information and neuter status. If there have been any changes since last registration, be sure to enclose required veterinarian certificates, which will be returned.

Licenses expire December 31st and are subject to renewal during January of each year. A late fee of \$10.00 will be added after March 31st.

Courtesy copies of renewal application are sent out annually to owners of pets previously registered in December of each year. It is your responsibility to renew even if you do not receive a courtesy copy.
